



Dress Code

Men

- Black suit with a white, button down, collared dress shirt and conservative tie
- Black socks and black shoes

Women

- Black dress, black suit pant or skirt (dress or skirt must be at or below the knee)
- Black hose (without pattern) and black dress shoes

MSC OPAS provides:

- A volunteer nametag

Guidelines:

- White shirts may have plain or button down collars. If the collars are button-down, the buttons must be clear or white.
- Dockers, casual slacks, denim or knit pants are **NOT** acceptable.
- Shirts, slacks, and skirts must be *free of ornamentation* such as lace, embroidery, beadwork, sequins, leather, taffeta, pinstripes and polka dots.
- Suggested fabrics for skirts and slacks include silk, rayon, challis, wool and jersey.
- Skirt hemlines must be at or below the knee.
- Women's dress shoes should be low heels, comfortable and safe on stairs.
- Shoes may **not** be open-toed or sling backs.
- Men may wear polished black dress boots. Slacks must be appropriately cut and lengthened for the boots.
- Make-up and hairstyles should be simple and understated.
- Men's beards and mustaches must be neat and well trimmed.
- Jewelry should be conservative.
- Gentlemen may not wear earrings, and volunteers may not wear facial jewelry.
- House Management will be the final authority on dress code.
